This month we have many celebrations to recognize...the first is Dia Los Muertos. The multi-day Mexican holiday that focuses on the gatherings of family and friends to pray for and remember those who have died, and help support their spiritual journey. It is a way for people to remember their loved ones.

The second week we will recognize National Native American Heritage month which aims to provide a platform for [Native people](#) in the United States of America to share their culture, traditions, music, crafts, dance, and ways and concepts of life. There are 110 federally recognized tribes in California alone.
