## OCTOBER 2019 NEWSLETTER

This month we are celebrating many events: Fire Prevention Week, Vegetarian month, Earth Sciences Week, Adopt a Shelter Dog (Animal) month, and Halloween. Our curriculum will focus on each weekly theme; please remember to bring in your item starting with the Letter of the Week.

For Fire Prevention we will talk with the children about what can start fires and how to prevent a fire from taking place. We have reached out to the Oakland Fire Department are hoping they can schedule a visit in class to help us with this topic. Once we have a confirmation date we'll let you know.

In recognition of Vegetarian month we will discuss what it means and why people are vegetarian. We'll discuss the types of vegetarianism: semi-vegetarian (eat only chicken/fish), lacto-ovo vegetarian (eats no meat/fish/chicken but intakes dairy), or vegan (eats no meat or dairy products and avoids any foods using animal byproducts i.e.-honey).

Earth Sciences studies the Earth's core to the outer reaches of space. It includes volcanoes, earthquakes, rock cycles, outer space, the weather, etc..

It is Adopt a Shelter Dog month, but we wrote Animals to include all pets. We will talk about how adopting an animal helps everyone; the pet, the adoptee, and the shelter. We will discuss why a pet is a part of the family and how to take care of one. **If you have an adopted pet, please bring a photo to share and write a small paragraph about your pet.**
