November 2019 Newsletter

This month we are focusing on the themes of : Chemistry, Puzzles and Games, Aviation History, and Thanksgiving as well as introducing and reviewing letters Ii, Jj, and Kk.

Chemistry is the branch of science that deals with the composition, structure, and properties of substances and the transformations they undergo. It is the study of the properties and interactions of matter and energy. We will talk about this subject in simple terms for the children to identify and understand. For example, we will explain that matter are categorized in liquids, solids, or gases. Solids are items like: rocks, wood, or ice. Liquids are items like: water, milk, or juice. Gases are items like: steam, air, or helium.

The next week is Games and Puzzles, these are fun learning activities for the children. If your child has a favorite game or puzzle s/he would like to share please label it and bring to preschool to share.

The third week of the month we will celebrate Aviation History and discuss the Wright Brothers, Charles Lindbergh, Amelia Earhart, and Neil Armstrong. We will discuss the types of aviation: airplanes, hot air balloons, helicopters, spaceships, seaplanes, gliders, blimps, and so on.

Our final week of November will celebrate Thanksgiving, what are you grateful for? We want to remind the children of how fortunate we are to have our family and friends as well as the basic necessities of food, water, and shelter. We will have our annual Alameda Food Barrel in the classroom for donations and speak with the children about sharing what we have with others and to remember there are those in need. Lessons of goodwill, compassion, helping, and giving will be emphasized.
