Hanukkah is the Jewish celebration also known as the “Festival of Lights”, which lasts eight days and includes nightly lighting of the menorah, special prayers, and fried foods.

Christmas is the annual celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ, many Christian customs during this time are gift giving, attending church services, special meals, and Christmas trees.

Kwanzaa was founded in 1966 as a way to celebrate African American heritage, community, family, justice, and nature. It is not a religious holiday; it's a celebration of unity and ancestry.
