Pride celebrates the LGBTQ community and commemorates the struggle to gain equality and overcome prejudices. The first week we are making projects such as a Pride flag and a rainbow which represent diversity and unity. We are also reviewing and identifying Letter Vv.

The week of June 21-25 is Summer Solstice, what types of activities do we enjoy in this season? Outside activities: baseball, soccer, kite flying, swimming, boating, camping, picnics, etc...We also change our eating choices in the Summer: BBQ meats, seafood, veggies, ice cream, salads, and cold drinks. The fruit is the mature ovary of a flowering plant and a vegetable is the edible plant part (leaves, stalks, roots, bulbs, and flowers).
