## JUNE 2023 NEWSLETTER

The month of June celebrates the following events: Aquarium, Pride, Summer solstice, Fresh Fruit and Vegetables, and reviewing and identifying Letters Xx, Yy, and Zz. We also review and identify #1-10.

The first week recognizes Aquarium month, what types of sea life live in the ocean? Have you visited an Aquarium? What did you see? Why is it important to take care of our oceans?

Pride celebrates the LGBTQ community and commemorates the struggle to gain equality and overcome prejudices. The second full week we are making projects such as a Pride flag and a rainbow which represent diversity and unity. We are also reviewing and identifying Letter Zz.

The week of June 19-23 is Summer Solstice, what types of activities do we enjoy in this season? Outside activities: baseball, soccer, kite flying, swimming, boating, camping, picnics, etc...We also change our eating choices in the Summer: BBQ meats, seafood, veggies, ice cream, salads, and cold drinks. What are your favorite summer dishes?

We transition next into Fresh Fruits and Vegetables, what types do you like? Why are they nutritionally important? What is the difference between Fruits and Vegetables? Our simple rule to help the children understand the difference : Fruits have a seed inside and Vegetables do not. The fruit is the mature ovary of a flowering plant and a vegetable is the edible plant part (leaves, stalks, roots, bulbs, and flowers).
