NOVEMBER NEWSLETTER 2024

It is the beginning of the holiday season and this month our curriculum topics are Dias Dos Muertos, Chemistry, and Thanksgiving. We will also review and identify letters Gg, Hh, and Ii.

The Day of the Dead is a Mexican holiday that is celebrated for two days reunites the living and the dead. Families create oferendas (Offerings) to honor their departed family members that have passed. The altars are decorated with bright flowers (marigolds), photos of the passed loved ones, and their favorite foods or drinks. These offerings are thought to encourage the dead to return and celebrate with the living in the celebration.

Chemistry is the study of matter, defined as anything that has mass and takes up space, and the changes that matter can undergo when it is subject to different environments and conditions. We'll do a variety of science experiments such as making a volcano, and slime.

Games and Puzzle Week is a time we like to teach children about cooperation, listening, understanding, and following rules, cognitive skills, fine motor skills, memory improvement, and eye hand coordination. Please feel free to bring in a game or puzzle for your child to share with peers.
